Language requirements: For non- native English speakers minimum score

required for IELTS is Band/Score 6 or a certificate from the Home University stating that -The student enrolled at the University has good English

Proficiency; hence they may be exempted from producing English Proficiency Certificate for undertaking semester abroad/ summer schools at our International

partners.

**Exchange Period:** One or two semesters

Course load: One course is generally of 3 to 4 credits

1 credit = 15 hours of contact session and at least the same number of hours of student work outside the

contact session.

\*Students need to attend lectures throughout the semester. Travelling can only be allowed during free sessions.

Eligibility: Minimum GPA of 3 on the Grading scale of 4

OR

Minimum GPA of 6.5 on the Grading scale of 10

(more than 75%)

**Course offerings:** Exchange student can choose courses (subjects)

across the semesters.

**Examination:** On arrival at SIU institute, the student will get an

opportunity to discuss the timetable and courses with the

faculty. The procedure for submitting assignments, evaluation will be explained. The student is expected to abide by the rules and regulations of the University



## **Application:**

- 1. After receiving the nomination from the home university.
- 2. Scanned copy of the following 5 documents as one pdf file & Valid Passport copy as separate document to be sent to us.

**Documents Required:** 

- 1. CV in tabular form
- 2. Statement of purpose
- 3. Latest Transcript of Home University
- 4. Reference Letter from home university
- 5. Recent photograph

#### Accommodation:

On Campus: Symbiosis provides on/near campus student accommodation. Separate rooms for male and female students are provided (mostly on twin sharing basis). Once a student opts for University accommodation, he/she will not be able to withdraw from it after arrival and will be liable to pay the accommodation fee for the entire term.

**Off Campus:** students can make arrangement for off campus accommodation on their own. No assistance is provided by the University for off campus accommodation.

This has to be notified to SCIE through mail at the time of application and in such case Foreigners Registration will be the responsibility of the student.

## **Arrival Information:**

The arrival information should be sent 15 days in advance to arrange airport pick up. Please note SCIE will not be able to accommodate students if they arrive before the date mentioned on the invitation letter due to strict Government regulations.

Nearest Airport: Pune International Airport

Distance from Mumbai International Airport to Pune: 3 to 4 hours by road.



**Expected arrival date:** Invitation/acceptance letter dates are mentioned 10 to 15 days prior to the term commencement date, which gives the student time to complete the registration formalities. The end date would be 5 days after term end date.
