The ISEG Economic Outlook for February, 2021 has been published.

The few quantitative data available for the first quarter of 2021 point to a visible drop in the activity in relation to the 4th quarter of 2020, namely of Private Consumption of 2020, namely of Private Consumption being very uncertain the behavior of the rest of the IP and PEL sectors. In any case, the data also suggest a fall of GDP lower than that recorded in the 2nd quarter of 2020 when the first period of containment was in force.
