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## INSTITUTE OF PORTUGUESE LANGUAGE AND CULTURE

IPLC offers a wide range of courses, aiming to meet the students' broadest range of interests and needs. The curriculum is organized into two semesters of 200 hours each (from A1 to C1) and one semester of 224 hours for C2.

### REGISTRATION

Registration deadline is 2 weeks before the Course start date. To register, the following must be submitted:

- › Registration form duly completed;
- › Copy of identification document;
- › Two passport photos;
- › Payment of registration fee.

*Additional registration period during the first week of the Course, subject to the existing vacancies.*

### PAYMENT

Upon registration, EU citizens pay 25% of the tuition fee and non-EU citizens 50% of the fee. The remainder must be paid within the first 3 days of classes.

Registration can be paid by check (to the order of: ADFLUL - Development Association the Faculty of Arts, University of Lisbon), money or bank transfer.

**Students who wish an invoice/receipt with tax number should give this information upon registration or when making any payment.**

*NOTE: Students must be 17 years old or over and have completed secondary education.*

Students are placed in the different levels according to the results of a assessment test to be held.

All courses require a minimum number of 8 participants and a maximum of 15.

If a student no longer wishes to attend a course and as long as the cancelation request is submitted in writing at least 2 weeks prior to the course start date, 50% of the registration fee will be refunded. After this period, no refund will be available. Transfer of registration to courses of other periods is not allowed.

### ANNUAL COURSE

Regular courses are held for learning the language and culture, corresponding to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR) levels. The courses work on a semiannual basis (200 hours), allowing for two levels per year to be attended in two alternative schedules: between 8 a.m. and 12 a.m. or between 2 p.m. and 6 p.m.

### AFTER-WORK COURSE

This course works on a semiannual basis and has a workload of 4 hours per week (18h-20h), making in each semester the entire 60 hours.

### SUMMER COURSE

In July, August and September IPLC holds monthly summer courses of 80 hours each, corresponding to a CEFR level (fro A1 to C1)

### ERASMUS COURSE

PFL course for Erasmus students from the Lisbon University.
