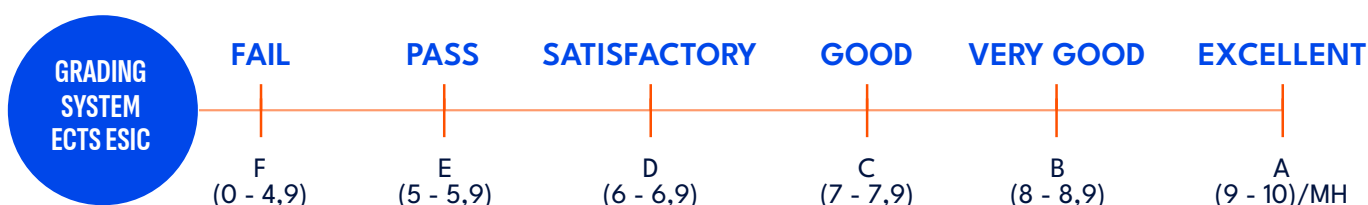

GRADUATE:

Units are graded on a scale of 01 to 100 points with the following qualitative equivalence:

FAIL 01 - 59

PASS 60 - 100

The minimum mark to pass each unit and the final dissertation is 60.
