For admission to the University of Maribor in the framework of the Erasmus programme, students must follow these 6 steps:

- apply for your individual password (at the web page mentioned above)
- complete the electronic Application Form and Learning Agreement
- print out the fully completed Application Form
- obtain the signature of the Erasmus academic coordinator at your home university; a university stamp is also required
- request a Transcript of Records from your home university; the Transcript can be in any form including computer print outs from your university registrar's office; it must be written in the English language
- fill in the form Self Evaluation of Proficiency in English Language, print it out and sign it send all required documents to:
