Language requirements	A minimum of level B2 (<u>CEFR level</u>) of English proficiency is expected.	
	No English test is required.	
Semester dates	The academic year starts in August and is divided into two semesters:	
	Autumn semester 2023: 14 August to 22 December	
	Spring semester 2024: 4 January to 14 June	
	Registration deadlines: 1 September (autumn) / 1 February (spring)	
Courses	ECTS scale: A to F or pass/fail.	
	Full semester workload: 30 ECTS	
	One course is normally 7,5 ECTS (45 lecture hours)	
	Language of instruction: English (and Norwegian)	
	Free Norwegian language courses 7,5 ECTS
