STUDENT VISA REQUIREMENTS

People entering the country for educational purposes for more than two days must obtain an Electronic Entry Permit (TIE 24H) or a student visa before arriving in Argentina. (Government provision #2023- 96270648 of the Dirección Nacional de Migraciones (National Migrations Department)). The TIE 24H entry permit may be requested by citizens from countries that do not require a tourist visa to enter Argentina (see list [here](#)). Students from countries requiring a tourist visa to enter Argentina will need to apply for the -365 or +365 visa, depending on the duration of their studies. International students studying in Argentina for longer than 90 days must acquire a Student/Resident VISA for their exchange period. Students should apply through the [nearest Argentine consulate](#) as soon as they receive their letter of acceptance, as the visa process may take up to 3 months. Both the TIE 24H and the visa can be processed as of 90 days before the start of the study period. Since the process can take several months, it is important to start the application at least two months before arrival in Argentina, or as soon as the acceptance letter is received. Universidad Austral provides students with the certificates they need to get their visa. The steps for the visa process are available [here](#). Students who will stay in Argentina for longer than six months will be asked to provide an apostilled certificate of good conduct (criminal background check) for the countries in which they have resided for more than one year during the previous three years.

HEALTH INSURANCE

You will be required to have a local health insurance policy that meets the following minimum coverage requirements:

- Medical benefits of a minimum of USD 150,000 per accident or illness.
- A deductible not to exceed USD 500 per accident or illness.
- Direct coverage at Austral University Hospital – not with reimbursement.
- Confirmation that medical costs are covered directly by the company and that the student will not be required to file for reimbursement for amounts exceeding the deductible. Repatriation of remains in a minimum amount of USD 7500.
- No coverage limits for pre-existing conditions.
- Coverage for mental health.
- Students in Psychology, Medicine and Nursing will also need an additional Vaccination Plan and insurance due to Hospital measures.


