STUDENT VISA REQUIREMENTS

People entering the country for educational purposes for more than two days must obtain an Electronic Entry Permit (TIE 24H) or student visa before arriving in Argentina. (Government provision #2023-96270648 of the Dirección Nacional de Migraciones (National Migrations Department)). The TIE 24H entry permit may be requested by citizens from countries that do not require a tourist visa to enter Argentina (see list [here](#)). Students coming from countries that require a tourist visa to enter Argentina will have to apply for the -365 or +365 visa, depending on the duration of their studies.

International students studying in Argentina for longer than 90 days must acquire a Student/Resident VISA for their exchange period. Students should apply through the [nearest Argentine consulate](#) as soon as they have received their letter of acceptance as the visa process may take up to three months.

Both the TIE 24H and the visa can be processed as of 90 days before the start of the study period. Since the process can take several months, it is important to start the application at least two months before arrival in Argentina, or as soon as the acceptance letter is received.

Universidad Austral provides students with the certificates they need to get their visa.

Students who will stay for longer than six months in Argentina will be asked to provide an apostilled certificate of good conduct (criminal background check) of the countries in which they have resided for more than one year during the previous three years.

HEALTH INSURANCE

You will be required to have a local health insurance policy that meets the following minimum coverage requirements:

- Medical benefits of a minimum of USD 150,000 per accident or illness.
- A deductible not to exceed USD 500 per accident or illness.
- Direct coverage at Austral University Hospital – not with reimbursement.
- Confirmation that medical costs are covered directly by the company and that the student will not be required to file for reimbursement for amounts exceeding the deductible.
- Repatriation of remains in a minimum amount of USD 7500.
- No coverage limits for pre-existing conditions.
- Coverage for mental health.
- Students in Psychology, Medicine and Nursing will also need an additional Vaccination Plan and insurance due to Hospital measures.

To be accepted as an exchange student at Universidad Austral you must commit to the following:

Dates

Deadline to apply: October 15th

March- June Semester

- Courses in English: From February 26 to June 30 (including final exams)

*In case you are also taking courses in Spanish, please read the document in that language, as dates are different.

Orientations

All of these are mandatory for all exchange students.

Before coming to Argentina:

- 1) Academic virtual orientation (November 10th)
- 2) General Virtual Orientation (November 17th)
- 3) In-person Orientations in Argentina:
 - Orientation in Buenos Aires City (February 26th)
 - Orientation in Campus Pilar (February 27th)

Campus

- Most courses are at our Pilar Campus- 1 ½-hour from the city.
- We recommend living in the city and commuting.
- Neighborhoods suggested to avoid traveling in the city: Palermo, Belgrano, Núñez

Academic requirements

- You must have completed at least 4 semesters at your home university.
- Good academic standing according to your university's scale.

Language Certificate

You need a language certificate to apply unless the language of the courses you choose is your mother tongue or the same at your university.

- For non-native English speakers, a B2 (80 iBT TOEFL / 6.0 IELTS / IB Diploma / IGCSE / Cambridge FCE) is expected for courses in English.
- For non-native Spanish speakers, an official Spanish language certificate, DELE or SIELE, equivalent to Level B2 or C1 of the CEFR. In case of other proofs of language, we will interview the student to confirm that the language level will be enough.

Learning Agreement

- You must include at least twice as many courses as you will be taking. Please keep in mind you won't be able to choose courses that are not approved by your coordinator in the original Learning Agreement.

Health Insurance

You must reserve local health insurance (from Argentina) before applying. The insurance must be valid at least from the first day you arrive in Argentina to the last day of the program.

For practical purposes, we suggest the plan provided by William Hope, because it has complete coverage and personal assistance 24/7. The monthly cost is U\$D 85 on average. See general description here: https://whoop.com.ar/estudiantes_intercambio

Reimbursement system is not accepted so the insurance needs to have direct coverage at Hospital Austral and other private hospitals in Buenos Aires. Also, repatriation of remains need to be covered in case of emergency.

Students in Psychology, Medicine and Nursing will also need a Specific Vaccination Plan and Additional insurance due to Hospital measures:

Those taking bio courses in Spanish should also provide a complete vaccination record and purchase a specific personal accident insurance.

Visa

Every exchange student studying at Universidad Austral for longer than 90 days, must acquire a Student VISA, before entering the country.
