International Entrepreneurship Blended Intensive Programme

6 ECTS, 10–14 AUGUST 2026

Erasmus+ Blended Intensive Programme, primarily for participating institutions. Understand the dynamics of entrepreneurship in an international context and learn how to discover, evaluate, and exploit international venture opportunities.

Ideation and Venture Creation

3 ECTS, 17–21 AUGUST 2026

Brainstorm and develop innovative ideas and learn the process of creating new ventures. Create early business models and practice to evaluate and pitch ideas.

2 ECTS, 24–28 AUGUST 2026
