

## **DEADLINES OF THE GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR KNOWLEDGE ASSESSMENT (RGAC) FOR THE 2025/2026 ACADEMIC YEAR**

### **Bachelors**

The marks for each test must be submitted ("submit" option) via Fenix, to the Degree/Masters/Doctorates Office, within the following deadlines:

- **Normal Exam Period – 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Semesters**  
By 72 hours before the respective Re-sit Period written exam sitting.
- **Re-sit Exam Period – 1<sup>st</sup> Semester**  
By the 18<sup>th</sup> of January 2026.
- **Re-sit Exam Period – 2<sup>nd</sup> Semester**  
By the 15<sup>th</sup> of June 2026.
- **Special Season Period**  
By the 13<sup>rd</sup> of July 2026.

The date/time/room of the consultation of exam papers session must be announced by email to the students, immediately after the finalisation of the score.
