"Although it was almost 30 years ago, in 1993, I remember perfectly the moment when I went to hand in my application for admission to the University. The member of staff who received and validated my form asked me several times whether I had made a mistake when filling in the part related to the options of degrees and universities, because I had only filled in only one option ...

However, more than just the good memories, of which I also have many, what I value most from my four years at ISEG were the following four tools and assets which still today are part of my day-to-day life, namely: ... the study and research method. The fact that a large proportion of the exams were subject to free consultation, guided the study towards the understanding of the key concepts, rather than just memorising everything, which is an approach that is much more useful for our professional life; ... the development of oral and presentation skills. The assessment method, which combined presentation papers during lectures, which was relatively rare 30 years ago, with the necessity to attend oral examinations to justify higher grades, required us to develop oral skills, rather than just writing skills; ... the "motto" of work hard, play hard. Academic life at ISEG was much more than just lectures and exams. Besides the various subjects of mathematics, finance, economics, etc., it was "obligatory" to pass with flying colours the "subjects" of sword games, bridge, or kings in the bar or those of football in the different tournaments. For fun is a relevant factor in our lives, as it energises us. ... an extensive group of friends with whom I still maintain contact almost 25 years after

graduating. We can no longer keep playing football every week, mainly for physical reasons, such as we did regularly for 20 years, however we have managed to keep meeting for big lunches or dinners and have had some unforgettable trips. Our goal is to check out the world's

Ending as I started, I don't know whether that was the most reasoned decision of my life, however I'm glad that I made it. If I could go back in time, I haven't the slightest doubt that I would make the same decision all over again ...and I would have a much more interesting answer to give when asked incredulously whether I was sure that didn't want to fill in at least one other
