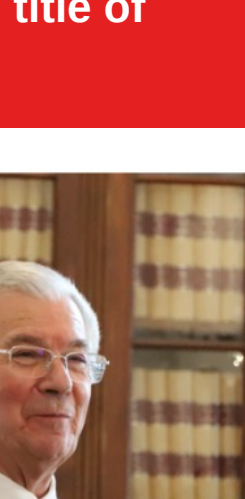
Award of the title of Economist Emeritus to Francisco Murteira Nabo by the Portuguese Association of Economists

The Portuguese Association of Economists (Ordem dos Economistas), in collaboration with the ISEG - Lisbon School of Economics & Management, organised a Tribute to Dr. Francisco Murteira Nabo on 28 February, in the Main Hall of ISEG, where he was awarded the title of Economist Emeritus.

Dr. Francisco Murteira Nabo was President of the Portuguese Association of Economists from 2002-2008. Among many other important positions, he was Councillor on Lisbon City Council, Secretary of State for Transport and Minister for Social Affairs (Equipamento Social). In the area of business management, among other positions, he was Chairman of the Board of Directors of Companhia Portuguesa Rádio Marconi, of Portugal Telecom and of Galp Energia, and also Vice-Chairman of Sorefame and of Nacional, and Executive Director of Ambelis and of Imoleasing (1997-2012). He was also Chair of the Association of Economists (2002-2008) and Chairman of the ISEG Alumni Association between 2001 and 2005.

The Tribute was attended by the Minister for the Economy and the Sea, Prof. António Costa Silva, who thanked him for everything he had done in the country for companies, the financial system and for the public good, praising his "ability to create collaborative networks".

The Dean of ISEG, Prof. João Duque, also attended the ceremony.

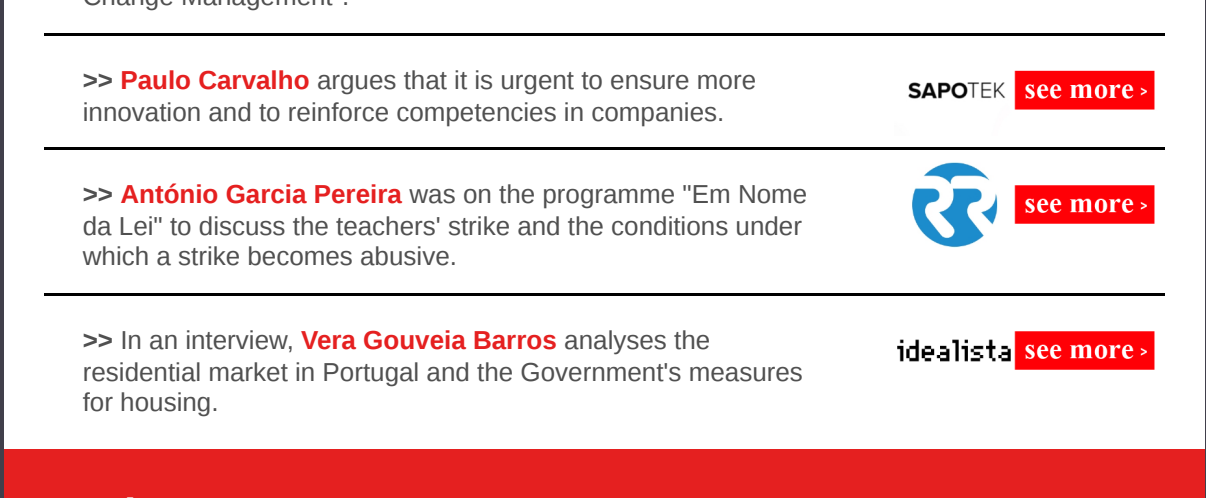

Formal Ceremony of the 2022-2023 Academic Year



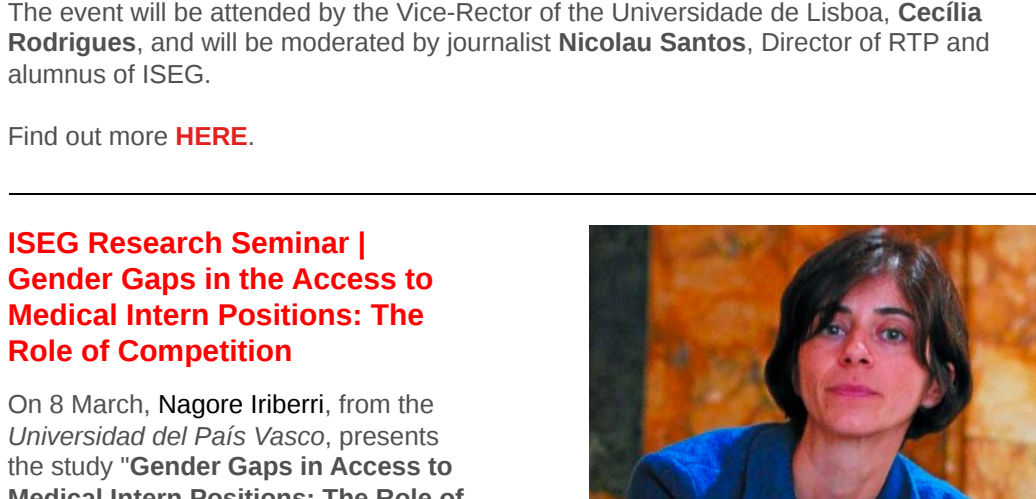
The Official Opening of the 2022-2023 Academic Year will take place on 9 March, at 17.00h, at ISEG (CGD Auditorium).

i2030 ISEG Seminars | International Market Challenges and the Role of Technology and Innovation in Boosting Industrial Competitiveness

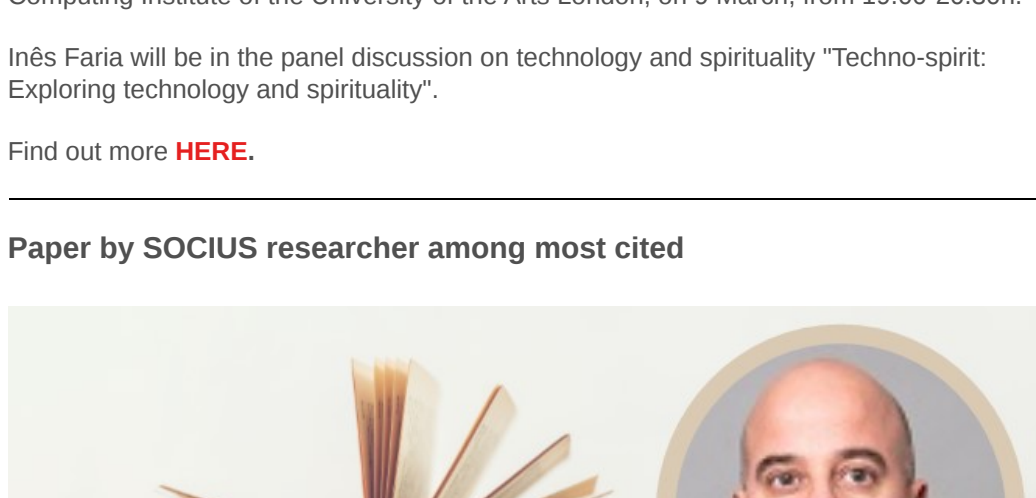
