The Open Stream is intended for high-quality submissions that do not clearly align with the Conference's predefined thematic Streams.

We recognize that innovative research and emerging topics often cross disciplinary boundaries or challenge conventional categories. The Open Stream provides a dedicated space for such contributions, ensuring that valuable work is not excluded due to structural limitations.

We warmly encourage authors whose work does not naturally fit within the established streams to consider this option.

Submissions to this stream should:

- Address topics relevant to the overall scope and objectives of the conference;
- Offer clear theoretical, methodological, or practical contributions;
- Comply with the formal requirements set in the Call for Papers.

The Organising Committee, supported by the Conference's Scientific Committee and the ESPAnet Board, will serve as convenor of the Open Stream, taking the responsibility for:

- Assessing submitted papers;
- Grouping accepted papers thematically, where possible, to foster meaningful discussion and scholarly exchange;
- Scheduling sessions and appointing Session Chair.
