‘Pitch Your Book’ Sessions

We warmly invite book authors/ editors to showcase their latest work by pitching their book at the ESPAnet Conference — an excellent opportunity to increase visibility and engage with an international community of social policy scholars.

Typically, ‘Pitch Your Book’ sessions are organised as follows:

- Sessions run in parallel with regular sessions;
- Sessions comprise the presentation of up to 3 books;
- Per book, there will be a brief presentation by the authors/editors, complemented by a brief discussion by a Discussant;
- The selection of the Discussant is of the responsibility of the book authors/ editors;
- The Organising Committee is responsible for scheduling the sessions and allocating the Session’s Chairs.

To be considered, books must:

- Be published in 2025 or 2026;
- Align with the core research interests of the ESPAnet community;
- Not have been previously presented at any ESPAnet conference.

If your complies with these requirements, please submit a 350–500-word abstract that clearly outlines:

- Main theme(s) of the book;
- Key findings and/or theoretical contributions;
- Relevance to ESPAnet debates and scholarship;
- Discussant, whose availability has been confirmed.

Book pitches will be selected by the Organizing Committee based on the extent the book fits the general research interests of the Conference and the number of presentation slots available.
