In the national top 10 for average entry grades, our Applied Mathematics for Economics and Management course once again proved to be one of the most demanding, with minimum averages of 185.1 and 183.9, respectively, in its Portuguese and English-language versions. also welcoming more than 800 new Master's students and more than 60 PhD students who have chosen ISEG for the continuation of their advanced education. 

This ranking places it at least 26 places ahead of any other university in Portugal. Of the 25 subjects on which it was evaluated, ULisboa leads 17 nationally: Environment and Ecology, Animal and Plant Science, Civil Engineering, Electrical Engineering, Computer Science, Mechanical Engineering, Energy Engineering and Management, Environmental Science and Engineering, Immunology, Neuroscience and Behaviour, Chemistry, Geosciences, Mathematics, Physics, Space Science, Economics

ULisboa rose 15 places in the NTU ranking, currently occupying 165th place worldwide.
